I am contacting you because I feel that supporting community energy security with an investment in the SES Solar Co-op may be of interest to you.

Thanks to the ongoing support of our members, our co-operative has played a significant role in advancing the renewable energy economy and reducing greenhouse gases in Saskatchewan.

Since our incorporation in 2015 as the first renewable energy co-operative in the province, we have collectively facilitated the construction of eight projects. In this latest project, completed in 2023, we have partnered with Case New Holland Industrial for a second time to significantly expand our installation at their location.

Our 270+ members now collectively own solar installations with a total of 2300 solar panels generating 975 kilowatts of energy at peak capacity.

SES Solar Co-op owns and operates solar energy installations that any Saskatchewan resident can invest in. We have the greatest solar resource in the country, providing us with a world-class opportunity to build resilience into our energy infrastructure for ourselves and future generations. By pooling our individual resources to invest in solar projects, we can create a sustainable energy source, offset greenhouse gas emissions from fossil fuel generated electricity, and provide a return on investment – all at the same time. Win, win, win!
